EBP - Educations Business Partnerships.

Oliver Kinnear was given a teacher placement four months ago, at Carillion. Afterwards, ten students came back to Carillion and worked on a curriculum project, which Oliver has developed.

Trident - Work Experience .

Carillion are giving Work Experience to six students between September and December this year.

"Safety On A Construction Site" Assemblies.

All of Swindon's middle schools were targeted last year with reference to safety on a construction site. The outcome was very successful and follow-up assemblies are being requested.

Southern Construction Careers Group.

Another seminar for the Southern Construction Careers will hopefully take place by the end of this year. The purpose of this seminar was to provide information, which will persuade careers advisory staff that a professional career in construction is challenging and rewarding - this is the message we want all of them to advise students when seeking a construction role.

Careers "Focus" Charity .

At the last "I promise" auction we managed to raise over £600.

A cheque presentation of £2,100 was given to Focus in June for all the money raised by Carillion staff.

Swindon Chamber of Commerce.

Carillion are back as members of the SCC. Ian Rothwell attended a seminar, representing Carillion and gave a talk on Sustainability. This was very successful and had very good coverage in our local paper.

Swindon Dog Handler - Drugs & Bombs .

Carillion have been involved with bringing two Police Dogs onto site, one during July and the other in August to help prevent drug abuse.
